You can add yourself, change personal information, change your school support for elector's purposes and add other electors under your address. On August 30, 2018 or later please visit the municipal office to check to see if you are on the voters' list and/or to be added to the list. You will need to bring ID with your name and address on it. e.g. Ontario Driver's Licence, Ontario Health Card w/photo, income tax assessment notice, child tax benefit statement, statement of old age security T4A (OAS), utility bill for hydro, water, telephone or cable TV. Please see complete list at www.mah.gov.on.ca and click on "municipal elections" If you are not able to come into the office in person, please call an election assistant for further information – a certified copy showing proof of ID and residence/occupancy will be required.

INTERNET AND TELEPHONE VOTING

How does it Work?

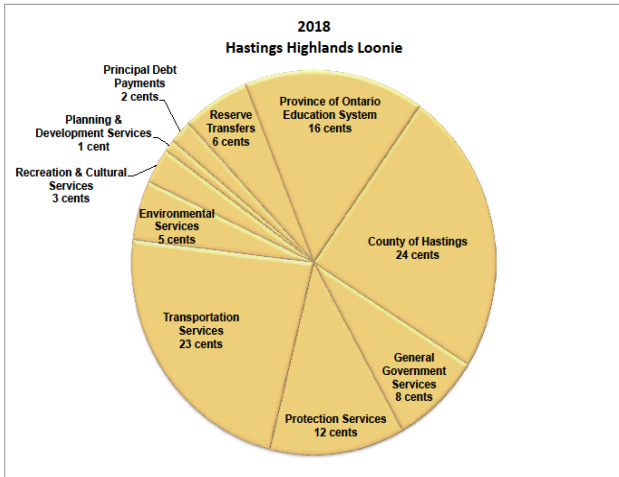
- 1) Electors will confirm they are on Voters' List
- 2) In early October, each elector will receive a personal **Voter Notification Letter** containing information to access the voting system including the voters' ID number, the voters' unique PIN to vote, the website address and telephone number for the voting system along with voting information and instructions.
- 3) Electors will be required to confirm they are entitled to vote when they access the system by entering their voter ID and PIN number contained in their notification letter. Once confirmed, the system will guide the user through the voting process. The voting period opens October 9th at 10:00 am and runs until October 22nd at 8:00 pm.
- 4) A Voter Help Centre will be located at the Municipal Office at 33011 Hwy 62 North in Maynooth to assist voters with: being added to the voters' list, provide clarification on the voting process, or offer access to a computer for voting.
