

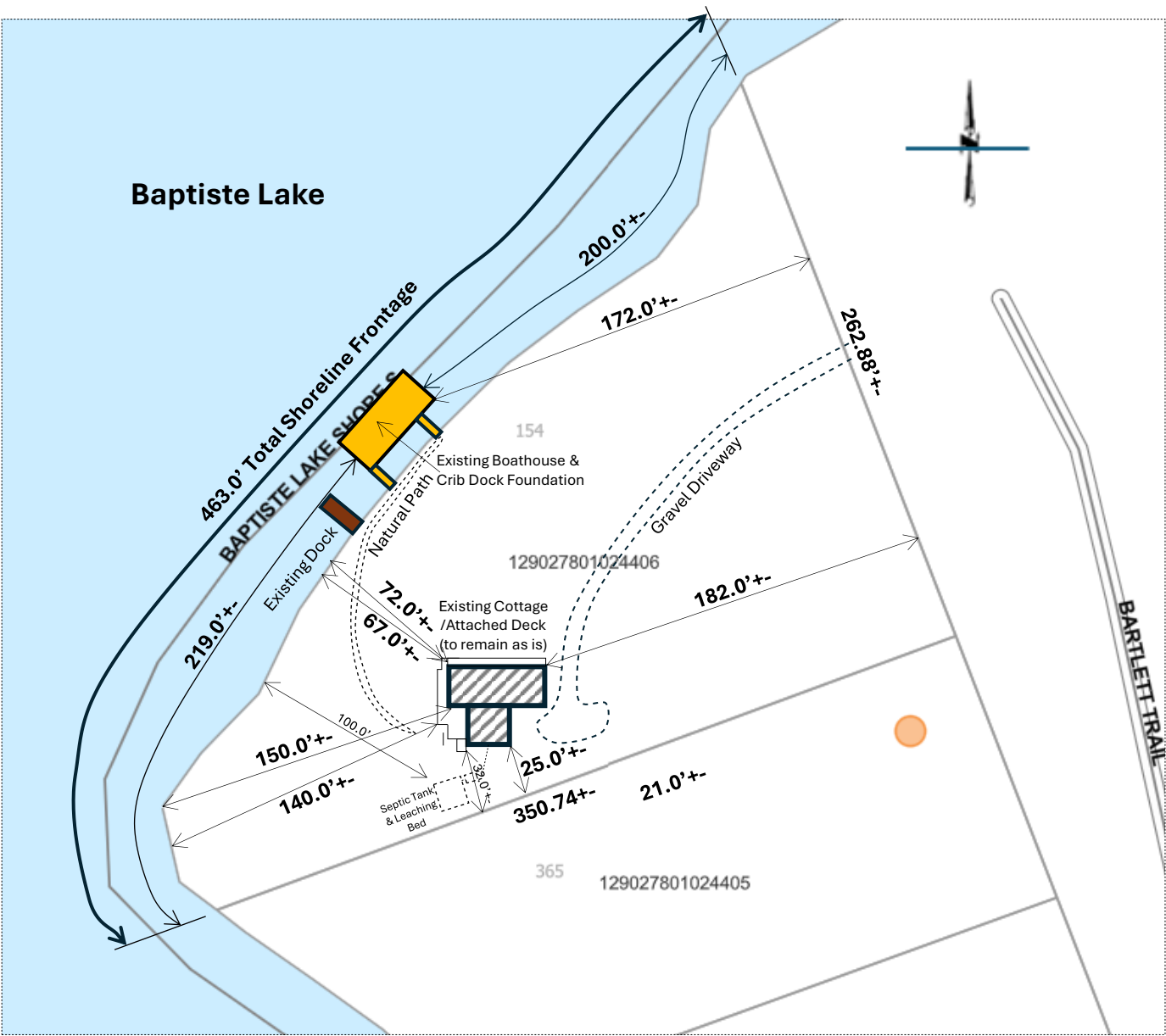

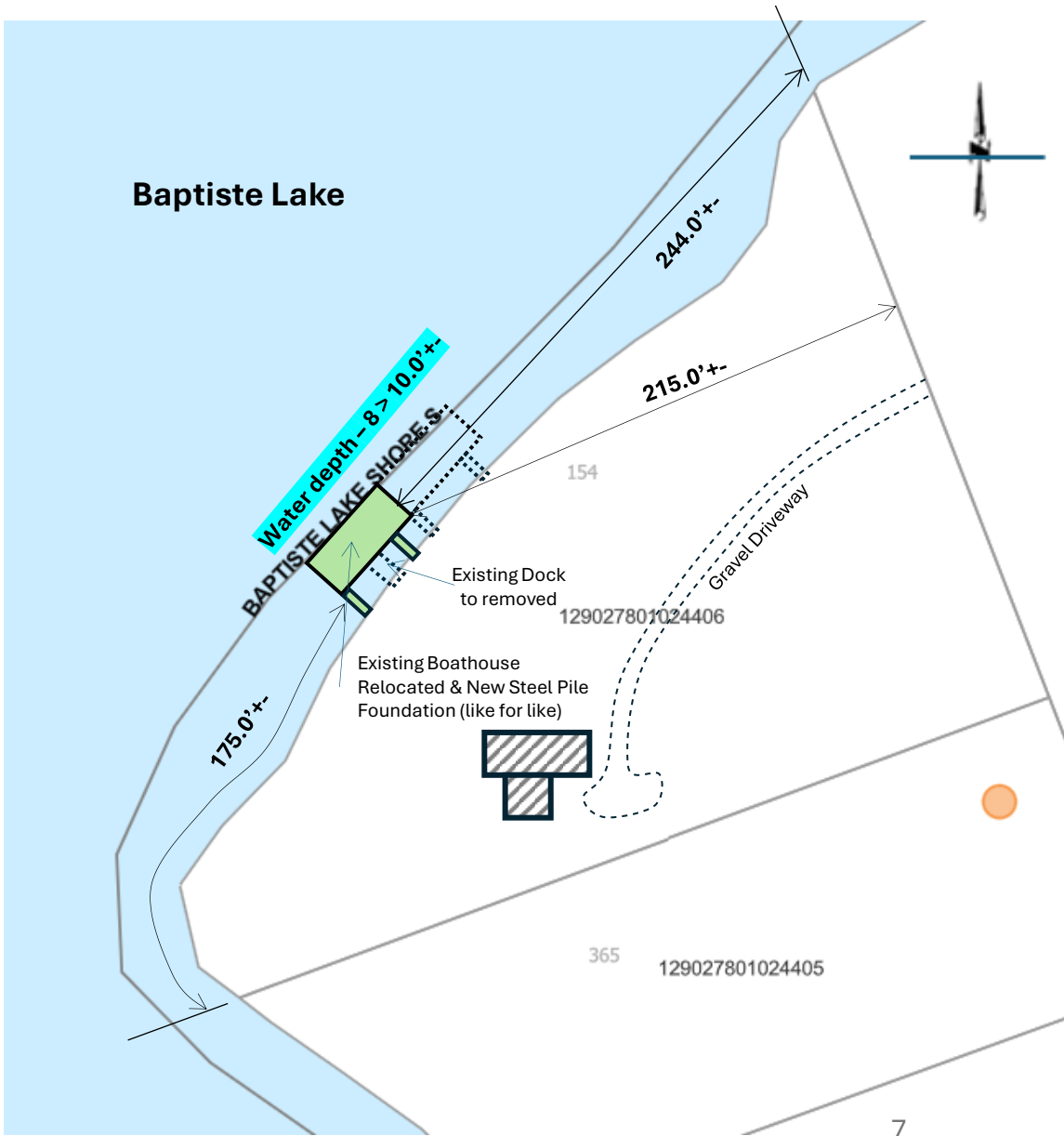

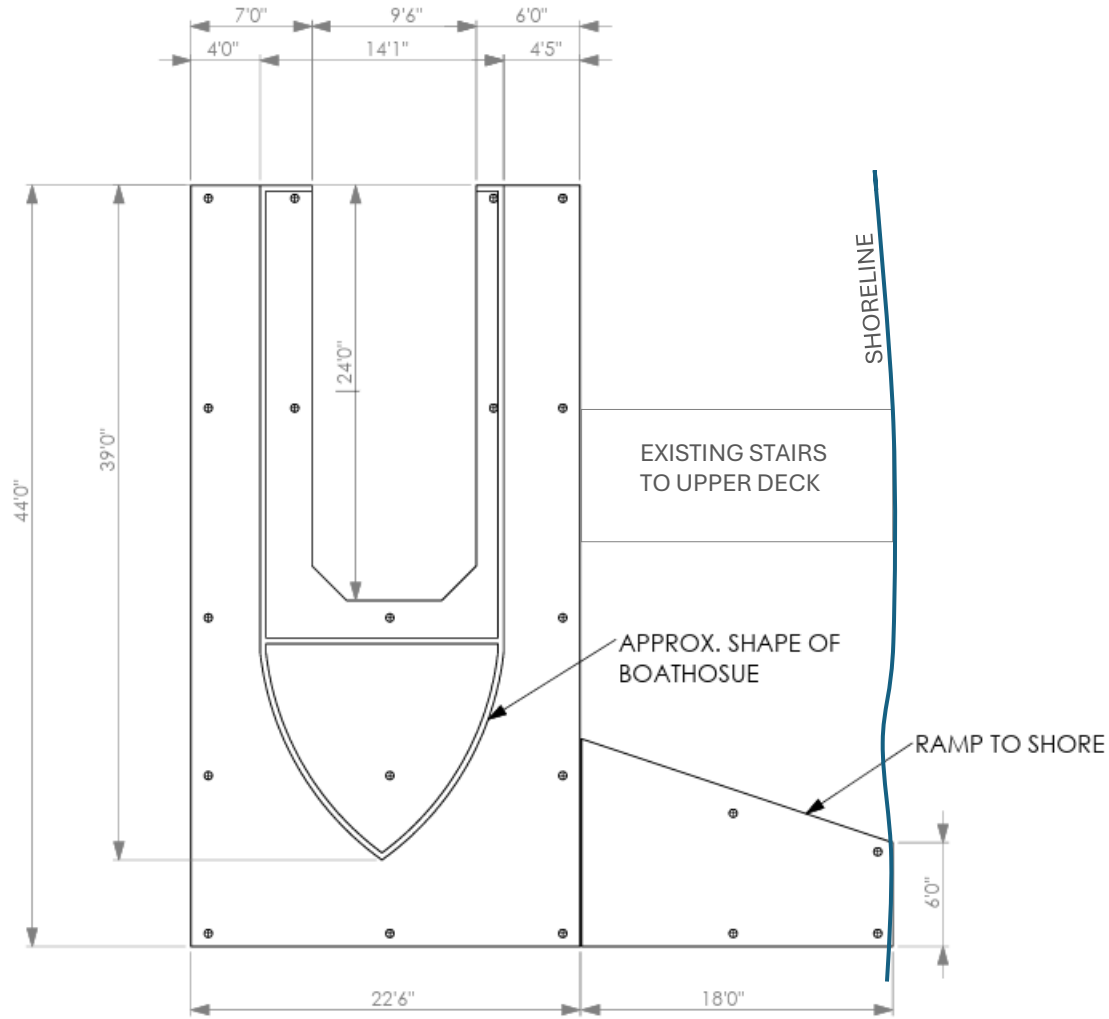
Existing Site Plan & Pirate-ship Boathouse Location



Site Plan & Pirate-ship Boathouse Proposed Location



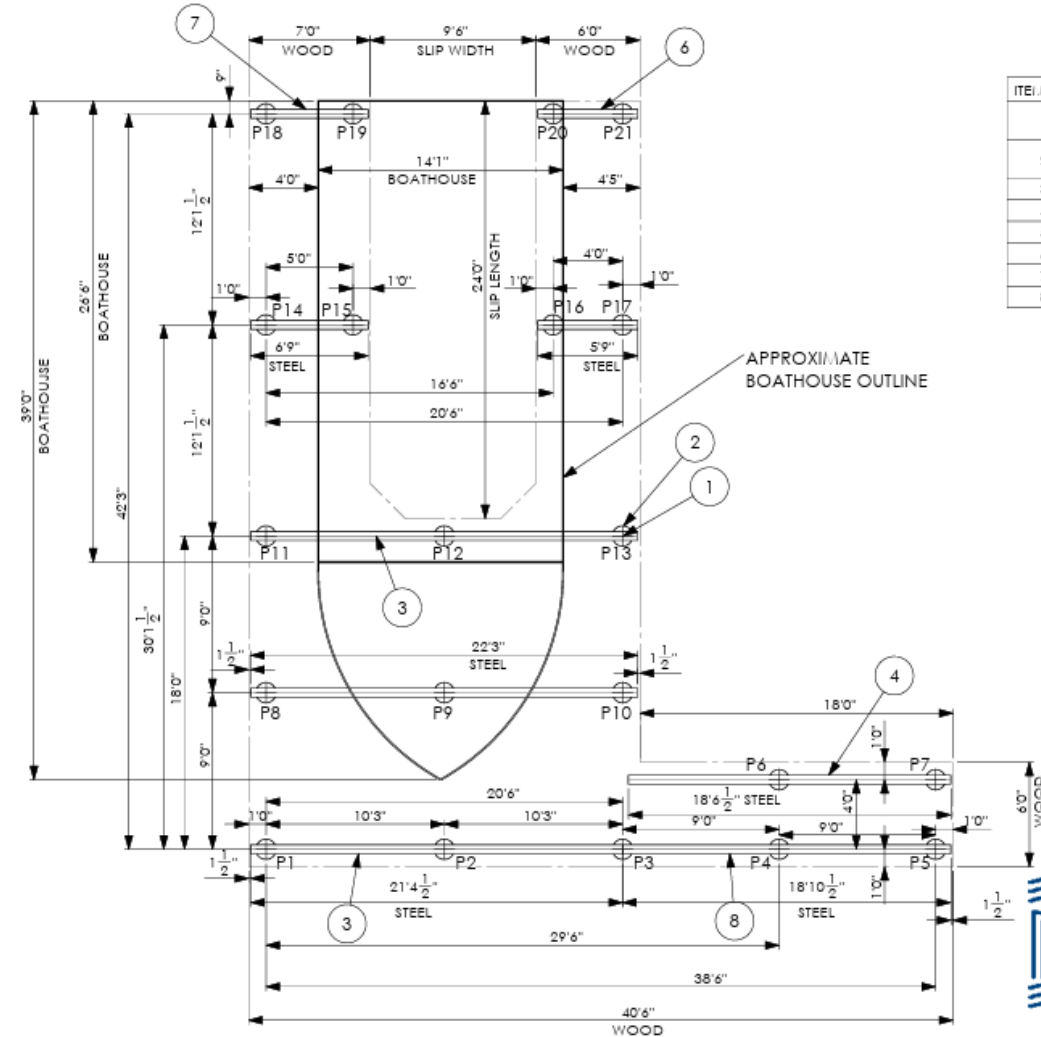
Existing Boathouse/Dock Layout with dimensions and replacement Steel Pile Foundation Layout built to the Northeast of existing location



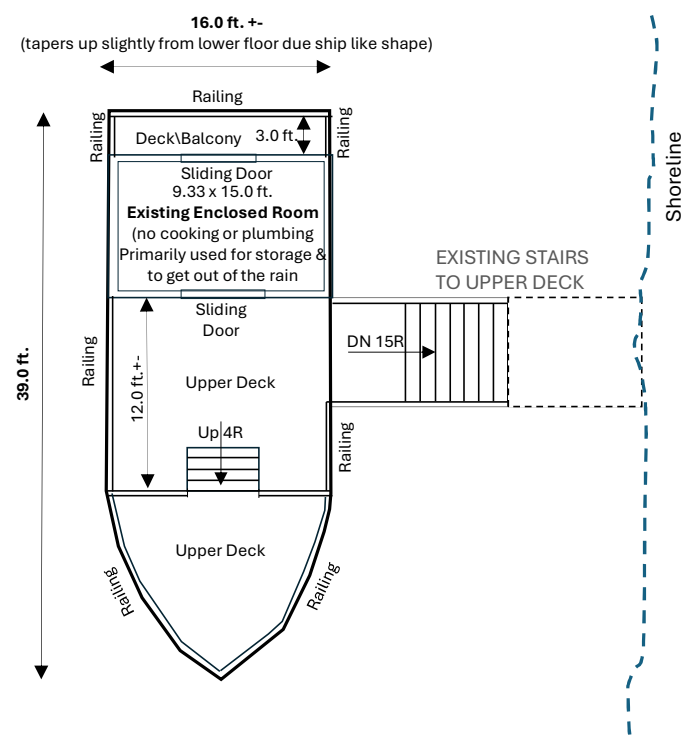

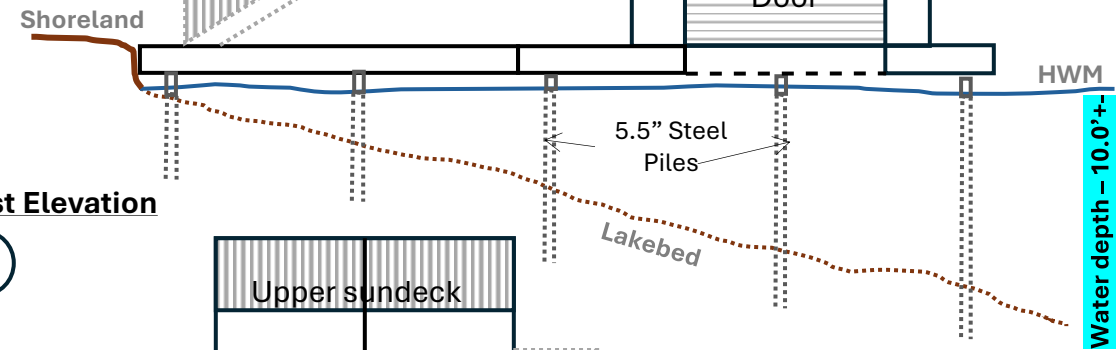
