

# **Job Description**

POSITION TITLE: Operator

## **REPORTING RELATIONSHIP**

Reports to and works under the direction of the Operations Supervisors through the Operations Manager.

#### **PURPOSE OF POSITION**

Attends to the Operation activities for the construction and maintenance of the Municipalities road system and adjacent public property, including the Municipalities Waste Disposal Sites, Parklands and recreational areas; the construction and maintenance of drains and catch-basins; the maintenance and protection of the Municipalities properties, buildings and public works equipment and other duties as required.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

Under the direction of the Operations Manager and Operations Supervisors

- Ensures all municipal vehicles and equipment are safe for operation
- Responsible for regular maintenance activities on municipal vehicles such as greasing, oil changes, light bulb replacements, etc.
- Operates all equipment as required
- > Reports for work on time and as scheduled
- Performs other related duties as required
- Complies with the Occupational Health and Safety Act
- Complies with all Municipal Policies and Procedures

## **WORKING CONDITIONS**

- Work is subject to road and traffic hazards; works around and in noisy equipment and vehicles; exposed to engine noise, heat and fumes
- Work is subject to exposure to extreme weather conditions
- Work is subject to peak periods, shifting priorities and deadlines
- Work is subject to unusual and unscheduled hours

### **WORKING RELATIONSHIP**

With the Operations Manager and Operations Supervisor

Follows instructions and directions regarding work to be completed, methods and schedules for completion. Receives leadership, guidance and direction

## With Other Staff:

Displays courtesy, co-operation, and teamwork with all staff.

## With External Contacts:

Maintains co-operative, congenial and courteous attitude with all external contacts.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS**

#### MUST HAVE:

- High School diploma or equivalency, and reading and writing skills necessary to comprehend and utilize technical information
- Valid AZ or DZ Licence
- Ability to demonstrate competence in the operation and maintenance of a road grader or hydraulic excavator
- Willingness to learn new skills through local instruction and formal courses
- Ability to take and follow direction from supervisor
- Mechanical skills necessary to operate and maintain equipment as required

### SHOULD HAVE:

- Experienced in a computerized work environment
- First Aid Training
- Surface Miner Certificate
- WHMIS Training
- Chainsaw Course Certification

#### **IMPACT OF ERROR**

- Must recognize that errors could add significantly to municipal costs, endanger employees and the public, and create poor public relations.
- Must make every logical effort to avoid such errors by seeking assistance and advice from Supervisor.
